Description:

Typically this unit would be used in an area where there is a damp atmosphere e.g. shower rooms or around an indoor swimming pool, or in sterile environments where cleanliness is paramount so the unit needs to be wiped down.

Perfectly suited for lifeguard chairs, wet rooms, kitchens, hospital theatres etc, the more prominent red "emergency" button is used to indicate an urgent situation as opposed to the smaller orange staff "assist" button for less urgent calls.

The green "reset" button not only cancels a call once dealt with, but if no call is active it can be used to indicate a "staff presence" in the room, without the need for generating a call onto the system.

The magnetic reset option means that without the special reset tool a call cannot be cancelled. This makes it ideal when a manager is required to attend a call as staff will not be able to clear a call once the unit has been activated.

Optional extra's for this unit to trigger an assistance call could be –

- ARM infrared call point upgrade to allow infrared keyfobs/pendants to be used

- Emergency
- Reset
- Staff Presence
- Low Battery
- Magnetic Reset (optional)
