



Optional Extra's

- o Ceiling mounted pull cord (Hard Wired or Infra Red version)



Description:

Typically this unit would be located in an ensuite bathroom beside the toilet, in communal W/C's, or living spaces like lounges and dining rooms. The service user can then easily pull the bright orange cord on the unit to call for assistance. Because the orange cord from the underside of the unit reaches the floor, the easy grip triangle at the base allows for the service user to call for assistance even if they are on the floor.

The large orange "staff call" button generates the next level of call indicating further assistance is required, whilst the red "alarm" button indicates an emergency situation.

The green "reset" button not only cancels a call once dealt with, but if no call is active it can be used to indicate a "staff presence" in the room, without the need for generating a call onto the system.

Optional extra's for this unit to trigger an assistance call could be –

- o ARM infrared call point upgrade to allow infrared keyfobs/pendants to be used
- o An Infra Red ceiling mounted slave pull cord unit
- o A hardwired ceiling mounted slave pull cord unit
